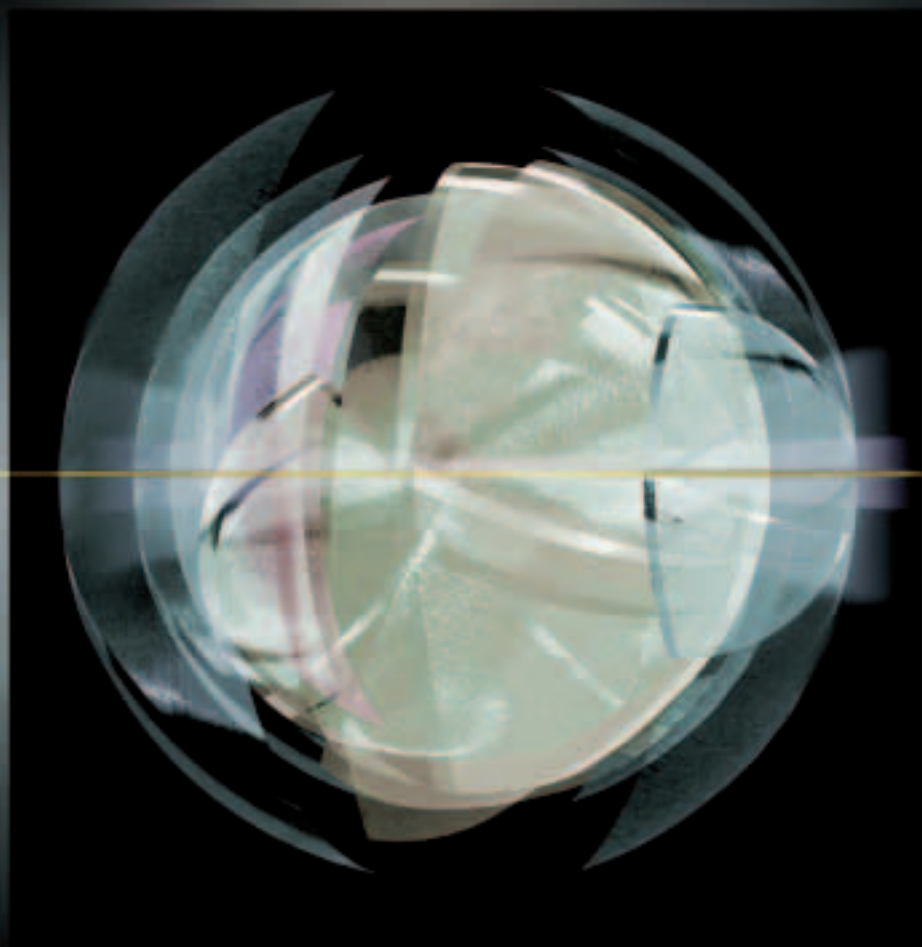

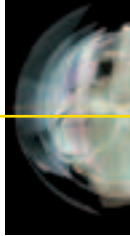

# PRESENTATION



Dear Colleagues,

I have the pleasure of bringing to your attention the 8th edition of the SOI International Congress that will take place in Rome from the 19<sup>th</sup> to the 22<sup>nd</sup> of May 2010 at the Congress Centre of the Rome Cavalieri Hotel (Via Cadlolo, 101).

The event opens with two novelties: **the works will start on Wednesday 19<sup>th</sup> at 2.00 p.m. and will close on Saturday 22<sup>nd</sup> at 5.15 p.m.** Naturally, it will be possible to register and visit the exhibition area as of 8.00 a.m. on Wednesday.

The positive experience recorded during the last national edition confirms Saturday as a full day of congress training. On **Saturday the Retina and Glaucoma Subspecialty Days** will be held in sala Cavalieri and in sala Belle Arti for a specialized full immersion, **from 8.00 a.m. till 5.15 p.m.**

This year, for the first time, during the two Subspecialty Days, a particular section of live surgery will be carried out, in connection with the operating theatres of the San Camillo Forlanini Hospital in Rome.

As usual, the 15th SOI-OSN AICCCER Joint Meeting, connected, on Friday and Saturday, to the live surgery session, as well as the SOI/SAO Argentinian Ophthalmological Society Symposium represent a moment of international exchange of experiences. The latter is focused on the post-surgery management of the patient with glaucoma, which will be honoured by the extraordinary presence of Prof. Anthony C.B. Molteno, Head of the Ophthalmological Department at Otago University, New Zealand. Both appointments are set on Thursday.

Furthermore, Prof. Molteno will take part in the live surgery section for a demonstration of the advanced implantation technique relating to the Molteno 3 drainage device.

Other two eminent names in the scientific landscape from overseas will participate in the Congress: Lawrence

A. Yannuzzi, professor of Clinical Ophthalmology at the Columbia University Medical School, who will be awarded the Gian Battista Bietti SOI Medal Lecture - he will present the Lectio Magistralis entitled "The Expanded Clinical Spectrum of Vitelliform Maculopathy" -, as well as Samuel Masket, professor of Clinical Ophthalmology at the Jules Stein Eye Institute UCLA Centre for Health Sciences USA, who will be awarded the Benedetto Strampelli SOI Medal Lecture - he will hold the Lecture on "The Future of Cataract Surgery".

Once again the International edition of the SOI Congress offers a rich scientific programme, with full recognition of CME credits, with over 28 sessions, 8 institutional courses and 24 training courses for a complete update on the main topics related to our profession.

This will foster a better-known profile of the union representatives for our category through a SOI meeting, in cooperation with ASMOOI, targeted to the training of those willing ophthalmologists who might offer to promote the needs of all ophthalmologists.

Moreover, SOI and ASMOOI are the promoters of a symposium focused on verifying future opportunities for a possible convergence between the role of the ophthalmologist and the orthoptist's, in view of a modern development of the orthoptist's professional profile.

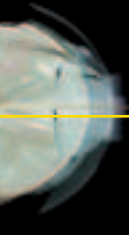
I wish to remind you that, for the SOI members, the Congress is totally free of charge, with no additional registration fee neither for participation to the Subspecialty Days, nor to training courses.

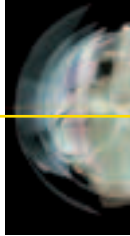

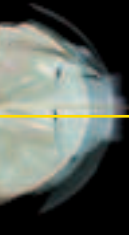

## **HOW TO PARTICIPATE IN THE CONGRESS**

To participate to the 8<sup>th</sup> SOI International Congress, to the exhibition and to all the congress events, it is necessary to be registered, to hand in the application form to the organizing secretariat and to be up to date with the entry fees (as in the following table).

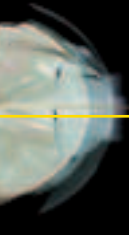

## **PERMANENT UPDATING PROGRAMME - CREDIT ACQUISITION**

The 8<sup>th</sup> SOI International Congress qualify participants to obtain credits established by the Health Ministry. ### **Computer Poster Session**

The presentations for the electronic consultation prepared by the authors may contain photos, as well as explanatory films (1 slide max 3 min).

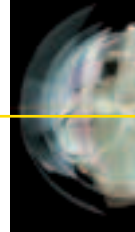
### **Technical Characteristics**

- Electronic Posters must be in Power Point Office 2003 or 2007 for Window (including all the attached images, as well as audios and films);
- a maximum of 12 slides;
- each slide can contain a maximum of 4 photo slides, plus 1 3-minute film;
- the weight of the whole file must be as light as possible, for a correct visualization on a 17" monitor.

### **Discussion**

Posters must be discussed in the sessions dedicated to them. The authors will have 3 minutes available to present their work.

## Badges

Upon registration at the Congress venue, all participants up to date with dues, will receive a badge with a personal photograph\* which, if transferred, will be declared void. Such a badge must be worn in a visible way. Access to the exhibition and conference areas is allowed exclusively after an electronic bar code check of the badge. Access to the Congress area is not allowed without a badge with photo. Before the beginning of the Congress, it is possible to send a picture in electronic format to the following address: congressi@sedesoi.com .

Should a duplicate badge be requested, this will automatically annul the previous one and will be charged 50 Euros.

\* Photo Station: should a Soi member receive a badge with no photo, he/she must go to the Photo Station.

In order to regulate the requests of the professional congress organizers, an entrance fee of 1,000 Euros is set for congress operators.

The accredited person can enter the congress and exhibition areas, but cannot have any set permanent location, nor distribute promotional and/or advertising material. Such material can be distributed only after perusal and approval by the SOI Board of Directors. The above-mentioned operators must present a written request for accreditation to the Secretariat at the Registration Desk in order to enter the Congress area. Accredited people will receive a non-transferable personal badge. Moreover, they will have to comply with all the safety regulations demanded to participants and exhibitors.

## Certificates of Attendance

The certificates, only valid for fiscal purposes, are issued solely upon request of the interested person and only for those days in which the participant was actually present.

## USEFUL INFORMATION FOR THE SPEAKERS

- All Congress rooms will be equipped with PC projection (1024x768 (XGA) resolution) as well as of a video projector only for DVDs. Slides or VHS projectors are not available.
- Speakers are requested to go to the Speakers' Ready Room at least three hours before their presentation, handing over to the technicians a copy of their work on CD, DVD and a USB memory stick. Their work can also be downloaded from their own PC at the Speakers' Ready Room.
- The use of the speaker's own PC is allowed only for Courses.
- Speakers are advised to make a copy on CD, DVD or on a USB memory stick of their presentation and to make sure with the technicians of the Speakers' Ready Room that their own PC is compatible with the equipment of the Congress. Speakers are also requested to be in the Congress room 30 minutes before their presentation.
- All papers must be prepared with MS Power Point 2003 (Office 2003) programme and "\*.pdf" (Adobe Acrobat) files, suitable to be seen with a 1024x768 (XGA) resolution.
- All the Congress equipment stations (Speakers' Ready Room and Congress room PCs) will be endowed with the updated version of OFFICE 2007 and the most widespread video codec: MPEG-2, DivX, Intel INDEO and Cinepak. The speakers using a video with a codec different from the one specified in this card are requested to bring, together with their presentation, the installation files of the codec used, to enable technicians to install them. This is the only procedure that can guarantee the vision of the videos in Power Point.
- For MAC users: speakers should save their work in Power Point. For the films inserted in the presentation, select the "Quick Time" option to save the film in "\*.mpeg 1 (2)", "\*.DIVX", or "\*.avi". The speakers are, in any case, required to verify that their equipment is compatible with the one in the Speakers' Ready Room at least three hours before their presentation.
- It is not possible to project a film and a PC presentation at the same time, inasmuch as every Congress room will be equipped with only one projector alternatively used to project a film or a PC presentation.
